

# Achieving Good Behaviour

## Our School Rules



- Children are expected to show respect, courtesy and consideration to teachers, fellow pupils and visitors to the school. The same level of good behaviour is expected while on school tours and other outings.
- Children should treat peers with respect, and have good manners at all times.
- A sense of respect must be developed in children.
- Children must respect all teachers, and staff in the school.
- Children must respect classroom rules and directions.
- Children must be made aware of the importance of attending school regularly with a neat clean appearance.
- Children are expected to keep books, copies and homework neat and clean.
- Children must respect the school's and each other's property.
- Children are expected to be punctual at all times.
- Children must share the responsibility of keeping the classroom and school grounds tidy and litter free.
- Children may not leave school grounds without permission.
- If pupils are being collected early we require notification.
- Children must wear school uniform every day except PE days when tracksuits should be worn.
